1. If a provision of the Assurances is violated


- After you violate a provision of the Assurances, you may receive a negative decision from METI against buying a new machine tool made in Japan.
- And also you may not be able to receive any service for other machine tools that have not violated a provision of the Assurances

- The provisions of the Assurances remain in force until you sell to a third party or scrap the machine tool.











Do not export the machines. If you want to export it out of necessity you must consult the supplier of it prior to the export. This supplier is for example its initial exporting company from Japan.
