

The Current Condition of the Japanese Machine Tool Industry

Monthly Machine Tool Orders (November 2015)

The total value of machine tool orders in November was 114.39 billion yen. This was an increase of 11.0% compared to October and marked the first month of month-on-month growth in two months. However, this figure represented a decrease of 17.7% compared to the same month of the previous year, with posting the fourth consecutive month of year-on-year decline. The total amount of orders topped 110 billion yen for the first time in four months. Moreover, this has passed 100 billion yen for twenty-seventh consecutive months.

For the domestic demand, we can see some effect of government policy and the trend to wait for the subsidies in next year.

With regard to the foreign demand, we will keep a close watch on the effect of world economy and EMS special demand.

Domestic orders rose by 2.2% over October, amounting to 45.46 billion yen. This marked the first month-on-month growth in two months. This figure was also a decline of 7.3% from the same month of the previous year and marked the year-on-year decrease in three consecutive months.

Looking at major industries, orders compared to October rose by 15.8% in industrial machinery, by 3.3% in motor vehicles, fell by 18.7% in electrical & precision machinery, and rose by 21.2% in aircraft, shipbuilding & transport equipment.

Foreign orders rose by 17.6% over October to 68.93 billion yen. This marked the first month of month-on-month increase in two months. While, foreign orders showed a decrease of 23.4% from the same month of the previous year, with November posting the sixth consecutive month of decline.

By region, orders from Asia rose by 35.4% over October to 28.73 billion yen. This was a decrease of 37.9% from the same month of the previous year. Orders from Europe fell by 7.9% from October to 14.17 billion yen. This was a decrease of 19.8% from the same month of the previous year. Orders from North America rose by 17.1% over October, amounting to 24.69 billion yen. This figure was a decrease of 0.9% from the same month of the previous year.
